All About Friends

The Enterprise Friends of the Library was re-established in the spring of 1995 after the library moved to its current location. Interested volunteers updated the by-laws, filled the board positions, and went to work.

Purpose

- To maintain an association of people interested in books and libraries.
- To focus public attention on library services, facilities, and needs.
- To generate funds for library support and improvement.
- To stimulate gifts of books, magazines, desirable collections, endowments, and bequests for the Enterprise Public Library.

Our primary fund raising events are the book sales. Money is also generated by patrons such as yourself joining the Friends. Since 1995, the Friends have raised over \$120,000 for the library. Library directors have earmarked these funds for many projects, such as purchasing library materials or up-to-date training for staff members.
