Volunteer

If you're interested in being a volunteer, here's what we do:

Weekly we sort, price, and shelve donations in the book sale room and Daily Deals. CDs and DVDs are checked, puzzle pieces counted. Volunteers advertise our book sales via social media and print media. We hand out bookmarks and post fliers around town.

The day of a sale, volunteers help customers with requests, tally up the sales, pack up the books, and help get the books to a car.

Our volunteer wish list ranges from those who have knowledge of social media and computer know-how to someone willing to hit the supermarkets and pick up the cardboard boxes we use to store books.

Receive an "Oops" membership card that entitles members to:

- a Spring and Fall newsletter that shares Friends news and sales information via mail or email.
- receive periodic email notification of special mini sales if member opts in.
- early bird access to our biannual book sales. Friends are invited to a members-only sale that usually occurs the Thursday before the sale for the general public.
- credit toward late fees. Forgot to renew a book? Your "Oops" card covers up to \$2.00 on two instances of overdue book fines during the current membership year.
- request a book. Volunteers will list the book and contact you if it appears in our collection. The book can then be picked up and paid for at the front desk. There is no obligation to buy; we're just being a good Friend.
